Rodula Gaitanou's acclaimed 2018 production returns in revival, reuniting conductor Matthew Kofi Waldren and designer Cordelia Chisholm with Lauren Fagan (Violetta), Matteo Desole (Alfredo) and Stephen Gadd (Germont).



## The Cunning Little Vixen

**Janáček**

Energised by Janáček's exuberant rhythms, *The Cunning Little Vixen* captures the joys, thrills, fears and sorrows of our existence – whether or not we have a tail.

This new production will be directed by Stephen Barlow, conducted by Jessica Cottis, and sees Jenni France (Vixen) and Julia Sporsén (Fox) in the leading roles.



## L'amico Fritz

**Mascagni**

A feel-good romantic comedy set amidst cherry orchards and vineyards by the composer of *Cavalleria rusticana*, showing us his gentler side and reminding us what friends are for.

Kiandra Howarth leads the cast as Suzel, the girl next door who captures Fritz's heart, alongside Paul Carey Jones (David) and Kezia Bienek (Beppe). Italian conductor Beatrice Venezia makes her OHP debut.



## The Pirates of Penzance

**Gilbert & Sullivan**

Chock-a-block with wit, charm and a treasure chest of hits, Gilbert and Sullivan's very model of a comic British opera sails back triumphantly back into Holland Park.

This co-production with Charles Court Opera will be directed by John Savournin, and stars Savournin, Yvonne Howard, Richard Burkhard, Daisy Brown and Frederick Long in the cast.
